PROFESSIONAL ACTIVITIES

In 1993, Sergey Shishkarev founded Delo Group, one of the largest holdings in the Russian transportation and logistics market and was the head of the company till 1999. Since 2014, Sergey Shishkarev has been President of Delo Group, currently he is Chairman of the Board of Directors of Delo Group. Sergey Shishkarev was elected twice to the Board of Directors of Novorossiysk Commercial Sea Port (NCSP).

In 1999-2012, Sergey Shishkarev was three times elected to the State Duma of Russia of the 3rd, 4th and 5th convocations, where he held various executive positions in the Committee on International Affairs, the Committee on Energy, Transport and Communications and was Head of the Committee on Transport till 2012. He is an author of over 50 bills in transport industry.

In 2008-2011, he held the position of Chief Delegate of the Federal Assembly of the Russian Federation in the Parliamentary Assembly of the Black Sea Economic Cooperation.

In 2013-2018, Sergey Shishkarev held the position of the First Deputy Chairman of the Marine Board under the Government of the Russian Federation and Head of the Presidium.

In April 2015, Sergey Shishkarev was elected Head of the Handball Federation of Russia. In February 2023, Sergey Shishkarev was elected Chairman of the Supreme Council of the Handball Federation of Russia.

In 2015-2018, Sergey Shishkarev served as the member of the State Commission for Arctic Development, headed the business council of the State Commission.

In 2018-2021, Sergey Shishkarev was a member of the Board of Directors of Global Ports.

Since 2020, Sergey Shishkarev has been Chairman of the Board of Directors of PJSC TransContainer.

In April 2021, Sergey Shishkarev became the member of the Government Commission on Transport.

In December 2022, Sergey Shishkarev was elected Vice President of the Russian Olympic Committee.

In March 2023, Sergey Shishkarev entered the Presidential Council for Development of Physical Culture and Sport.

EDUCATION

In 1985, Sergey Shishkarev entered Minsk State Institute of Foreign Languages, during his second year he was enlisted and he served in the Northern Fleet Marine.

By the command's referral, he entered the Military Red Banner Institute of the Ministry of Defense, Department of Western Languages, and graduated with honors in 1992 with a military interpreter degree in Portuguese and Hungarian. Reserve colonel.

In 2001, Sergey Shishkarev got his Ph.D. in Legal Science on "Law Enforcement in France".

In 2003, he graduated with honors from the Russian Academy of Public Administration under the President of the Russian Federation (RAPA), with a degree in Finance, Taxation and Credit.

Sergey Shishkarev is the author of over 30 publications about anticorruption legal order in the Russian Federation. Defended doctoral thesis "Legal Order in Prevention of Corruption Realm: Theoretical and Legal Research", DJS.

AWARDS

Sergey Shishkarev is the honoree of the Second-Class Medal of the Order for Merit to the Fatherland, "300 years of the Russian Navy" Medal, Badge of Honor of Russian State Duma "For Merits in Parliamentarism Development" and other official awards. He was awarded for restoration of Orthodox churches with the Third-Class Order of Holy Prince Daniel of Moscow, and the Third-Class Order of Russian Orthodox Church of Reverend Sergius of Radonezh.

In 2017, Sergey Shishkarev was awarded the Order of Friendship for successful preparation of athletes who achieved high sporting results at XXXI Olympic Games-2016 in Rio-de-Janeiro (Brazil). In 2022, Sergey Shishkarev was awarded the Order of Honor for successful preparation and training of athletes who achieved high sporting results at XXXII Summer Olympic Games and XVI Paralympic Games in Tokyo (Japan).

In 2018, Sergey Shishkarev was awarded the title of the Honorary Citizen of Novorossiysk.
