PROFESSIONAL ACTIVITIES

In 1993, Sergey Shishkarev founded Delo Group, one of the largest Russian transportation holding companies, and remained at its head until 1999. Mr. Shishkarev was elected twice to the Board of Directors of Novorossiysk Commercial Sea Port (NCSP).

In 1999-2012, Mr. Shishkarev was three times elected to the State Duma of Russia of the 3rd, 4th and 5th convocations, where he held various executive positions in the Committee on International Affairs, the Committee on Energy, Transport and Communications and was Head of the Committee on Transport till 2012. He is an author of over 50 bills in transport industry.

In 2008-2011, he held the position of a Chief Delegate of the Federal Assembly of the Russian Federation in the Parliamentary Assembly of the Black Sea Economic Cooperation.

In 2013-2018, Sergey Shishkarev was in position of the First Deputy Chairman of the Marine Board under the Government of the Russian Federation and Head of the Presidium.

Since July 2014, Sergey Shishkarev has been the President of Delo Group, currently he is the Chairman of the Board of Directors.

In April 2015, Sergey Shishkarev was elected Head of the Handball Federation of Russia, since February 2023 – Chairman of the Supreme Council of the Federation.

In 2015-2018, Sergey Shishkarev served as the member of the State Commission for Arctic Development, headed the business council of the State Commission.

In 2018-2021, Sergey Shishkarev was a member of the Global Ports Investments' Board of Directors.

Since 2020, Sergey Shishkarev has been the Chairman of the Board of Directors of PJSC TransContainer.

In April 2021, Sergey Shishkarev was included in the Government Commission on Transport.

Since December 2022, Sergey Shishkarev has been the Member of Russian Olympic Committee Executive Board.

In March 2023, Sergey Shishkarev entered the Presidential Council for the Development of Physical Culture and Sport.

In August 2024, Sergey Shishkarev was included in the Marine Board of the Russian Federation.

In February 2025, Sergey Shishkarev was included in the Presidential Council for the State demographic and family policy.

EDUCATION

In 1985, Sergey Shishkarev entered Minsk State Institute of Foreign Languages, during his second year he was drafted in the military where he served in the Marine Corps of the Northern Fleet.

On the recommendation of the command he entered the Military Red Banner Institute of the Ministry of Defense, Department of Western Languages, and graduated with honors in 1992 with a military interpreter degree in Portuguese and Hungarian. Reserve colonel.

In 2001, Sergey Shishkarev defended Ph.D. thesis in Legal Science on the subject "France Police system".

In 2003, he graduated with honors from the Russian Academy of Public Administration under the President of the Russian Federation (RAPA), with a degree in State and Municipal Management specializing in Finance, Taxation and Credit.

Defended doctoral thesis "Legal Order in Prevention of Corruption Realm: Theoretical and Legal Research", Doctor of Law.

AWARDS

Sergey Shishkarev is the honoree of the Medal of the Order for Merit to the Fatherland Second Class, “300 years of Russian Fleet” Medal, Badge of Honor of Russian State Duma for “Merit in Parliamentarism Development” and other official awards. He was awarded for restoration of Orthodox churches with the Order of Russian Orthodox Church of Blessed Knyaz Daniil Moskovskiy, the Order of Russian Orthodox Church of Reverend Sergiy Radonezhskiy.

On May 18, 2017, by the Presidential Decree Sergey Shishkarev was awarded with the Order of Friendship for successful preparation of athletes who achieved high sporting results (gold) at XXXI Olympic Games-2016 in Rio-de-Janeiro (Brazil”).

On 17th of July 2018, Sergey Shishkarev was awarded the honorary title of the Honorary Citizen of Novorossiysk by the City Duma Decree No 317.

On July 1, 2022, Sergey Shishkarev was awarded with the Order of Honor for ensuring successful preparation and training of athletes who achieved high sporting results at XXXII Olympic Games and XVI Paralympic Games in Tokyo (Japan).
